PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Honolulu (legacy tandem) switch are associated with CLI code **HNLLHIMN06T** and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Honolulu (new tandem) switch are associated with CLI code **HNLLHIMNGT3** and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Mililani tandem switch are associated with CLI code **MILNHICOGT1** and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Hawaiian Telcom HNLLHIMN06T switch, located at 1177 Bishop St., Honolulu, HI 96813, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the HNLLHIMNGT3 switch located at 1177 Bishop St., Honolulu, HI 96813 and to the MILNHICOGT1 switch located at 95275 Kipapa Dr., Mililani, HI 96789. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), Intra-LATA traffic, and local traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the HNLLHIMNGT3 switch.

Interconnecting carriers will be contacted by the Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. Wholesale Account Management Team during January and February of 2019 in order to discuss the coordinated transition of active trunk groups to the HNLLMNGT3. Direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the HNLLHIMN06T switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the HNLLHIMN06T switch (**on or after April 3, 2019**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the five (5) native codes currently served by the HNLLHIMN06T switch to reflect the HNLLHIMNGT3 and the MILNHICOGT1 switches as the new home switches.
