Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Hawaiian Telcom Kaaawa Central Office (KAAAHICO), located at 51-476 Lihimauna Road, Kaaawa, HI 96730, which currently houses a Nokia 5ESS ORM switch for POTS services, ASAM 7300 for high-speed internet services, and TA3000 and various other channel banks for dedicated circuits, will be collapsed. All existing equipment will be decommissioned and replaced by a pole mounted cabinet equipped with a TA5000 broadband loop carrier (KAAAHIAHRL0), which will be cabled out to intercept existing copper cables to continue providing POTS, high-speed internet and dedicated circuits to existing end users.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Independent LECs, CLECs and Interexchange Carriers interconnection arrangements for traffic currently originating from and terminating to the Kaaawa end office switch will be affected by the planned network change; all such connections will be migrated to the TA5000 broadband loop carrier. Due to the physical collapse of the central office, collocation will no longer be available.
