Your TV service just got smarter! Your new Fioptics+ TV service, powered by TiVo, brings a fresh experience to your screen. While it may differ slightly from your previous TV setup, these quick tips will have you up and running quickly.

Watching TV

After turning on your Fioptics+ TV, you will see a menu of options. To dive into live TV, scroll to Watch TV and press OK on your remote.

Channel Numbers

Enjoy the simplicity of all HD channels-no need for those extra digits! Simply enter the channel number.

Recording Shows

OnePass takes your DVR to the next level! To record your favorite shows:

- Press Guide on your remote
- Scroll to find your program and press OK
- Select OnePass to record the series or record the individual episode

Playing Recorded Shows

Access your recorded content effortlessly:

- Press the TiVo button
- Use the arrows keys to navigate to My Shows and press OK to play

TiVo Button

If you get lost while navigating, simply press the TiVo button on your remote to return to the main menu.



Adding Apps

Add apps and games to your menu so you can access all your entertainment content from one place.

- Scroll to Apps and Games
- Select your app
- Don't see your app? Go to the Google Play Store and find it there



If your TV remains idle, it will display a screen saver. Just hit the **OK** button on your remote to resume your previous activity.



Last Button

Now located on the bottom right of your remote, this button will go to the last channel you were on previously.



Live TV Button Use this button to swiftly access the live TV feed.



Netflix Button

Easily access your Netflix account from your remote.

My Shows

My Shows will display all available viewing options for your recorded show, including on other subscriptions. A subscription to the streaming service may be required to watch if the show is not recorded on your DVR.
