This copper retirement notice is for one address, 841 Bishop Street, Honolulu, HI 96813, served by the Honolulu/Alakea Central Office, which is located at 1177 Bishop Street, Honolulu, HI 96813.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

Hawaiian Telcom has engaged in a project to upgrade the network in the area and therefore will retire the copper facilities and replace them with fiber-to-the-premises for 841 Bishop Street, Honolulu, HI 96813, served by the Honolulu/Alekea Central Office.

Description of reasonably foreseeable impact(s) of the planned change(s):

After the retirement of the copper facilities, Hawaiian Telcom will:

- (1) no longer offer services over copper facilities, and
- (2) cease maintaining the copper facilities.

Description of any changes in prices, terms, or conditions that will accompany the planned change(s):

As a general matter, the retirement of copper facilities will not result in changes to rates, terms, and conditions in cases where the affected service is converted to a like-for-like service that is available on fiber facilities. In cases where the interconnecting entities elect to replace the affected service with an alternative service that Hawaiian Telcom offers on fiber facilities, the rates, terms, and conditions will be as set forth in the tariff and its associated rate guide or agreement under which Hawaiian Telcom offers the alternative service.
