Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

Hawaiian Telcom Inc. ("HTI" or "Company") has provided notice on a separate filing that it is retiring metallic copper feeder facilities to specific distribution areas ("DA") on the island of Oahu due to Kona low storms ("Kona Lows") that destroyed telephone facilities in portions of the Waialua Central Office located at the address above. HTI is filing this switch decommission in conjunction with the copper retirement of the Central Office on the same day, April 10, 2026.

The Hawaiian Telcom Waialua Central Office voice switch (WLUAHICORS0), located at 66-373 Waialua Beach Rd, Waialua, Hawaii will be decommissioned and removed from the network after all end users served by this switch are migrated.

Description of reasonably foreseeable impact(s) of the planned change(s):

No carriers interconnect at the Waialua Central Office, and therefore, there will be no impact on any connected telephone exchange service providers.
