- All references to the Honolulu (existing legacy tandem) switch are associated with CLI code **HNLLHIMN06T** and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Honolulu (new tandem) switch are associated with CLI code **HNLLHIMN06T** and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Hawaiian Telecom, Inc. (“Hawaiian Telecom” or “Company”) HNLLHIMN06T legacy tandem switch, located at 1177 Bishop St, Honolulu, HI 96813, will be retired and replaced after all traffic served by this switch, is migrated to the new tandem switch identified by the same CLI code, HNLLHIMN06T, located at 1177 Bishop St, Honolulu, HI 96813. Traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), Intra-LATA traffic, and local traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers are required to submit an ASR to facilitate the migration of their trunks and obtain updated design layout reports. All ASRs must carry the project code of C20HNL.

Interconnecting carriers are encouraged to submit ASRs for the new tandem HNLLHIMN06T switch by July 27, 2020 but no later than August 10, 2020 in order to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic as described below:

The migrations from the legacy tandem switch to the new tandem switch will be a coordinated “hot-cut”. There will be a brief outage as the trunk group translations and associated T1s are moved. HT will perform automated tests on the T1s and once passed, the carriers will be required to conduct “call-thru tests” with Hawaiian Telecom. Once all tests are completed and passed, the trunk group migration will be considered complete. This process will be repeated until all trunk groups have been migrated.

After all carriers have been migrated, competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will be able to secure new or disconnect existing trunk groups built to the new **HNLLHIMN06T** tandem switch.
