Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Hawaiian Telcom Honaunau Central Office GTD-5 switch (HNAUHCORS1), located at 84-5022 Mamalahoa Hwy, Captain Cook, HI 96704, will be decommissioned and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to and replaced by an Adtran TA5000 (HNAUHCOTO). All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), Intra-LATA traffic, and local traffic. POTS, high-speed Internet and dedicated circuits to existing end users will continue.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Independent LECs, CLECs, Payphone Service Providers, and Interexchange Carriers interconnection arrangements for traffic currently originating from and terminating to the Honaunau end office switch will be affected by the planned network change; all such connections will be migrated to the TA5000 loop carrier. Services provided by the TA5000 may be incompatible with certain end-user equipment.
