Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Hawaiian Telcom Mokapu Central Office (MKPUHICO), located at 253 Iliaina Street, Kailua, HI 96734, which currently houses a GTD5 switch for POTS services, ASAM 7300 for high-speed Internet services, and TA3000 and various other channel banks for dedicated circuits, will be collapsed. All existing equipment will be decommissioned and replaced by a pad mounted cabinet equipped with a TA5000 broadband loop carrier (KAILHIICRL0), an ASAM 7300 (KAILHIICBB1), a Fujitsu FW4100ES fiber terminal (KAILHIICO01), and an Adtran TA3000 (KAILHIICHDA) and TA1500 (KAILHIICHDC) for dedicated circuits. All equipment will be cabled out to intercept existing copper cables to continue providing POTS, high-speed Internet and dedicated circuits to existing end users.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Independent LECs, CLECs, Payphone Service Providers, and Interexchange Carriers interconnection arrangements for traffic currently originating from and terminating to the Mokapu end office switch will be affected by the planned network change; all such connections will be migrated to the TA5000 broadband loop carrier. Due to the physical collapse of the central office, collocation will no longer be available.
